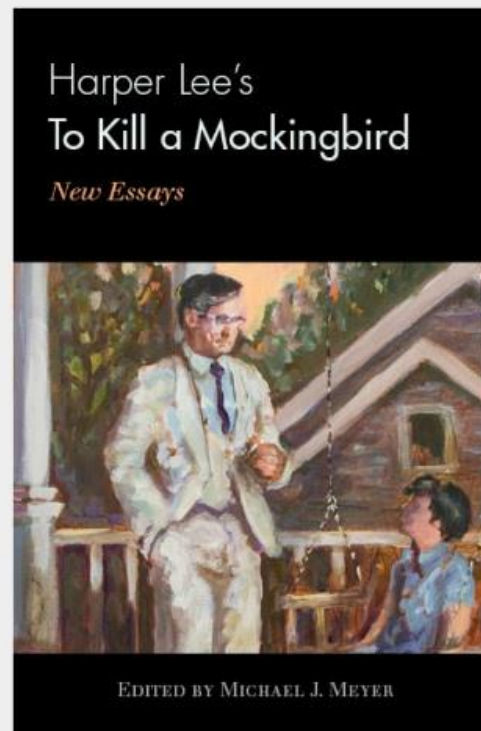

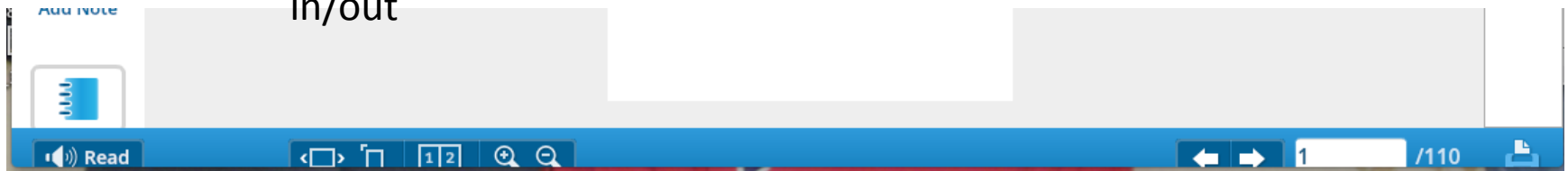

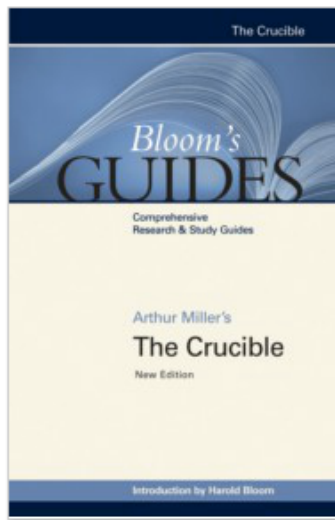
READER CONTROLS

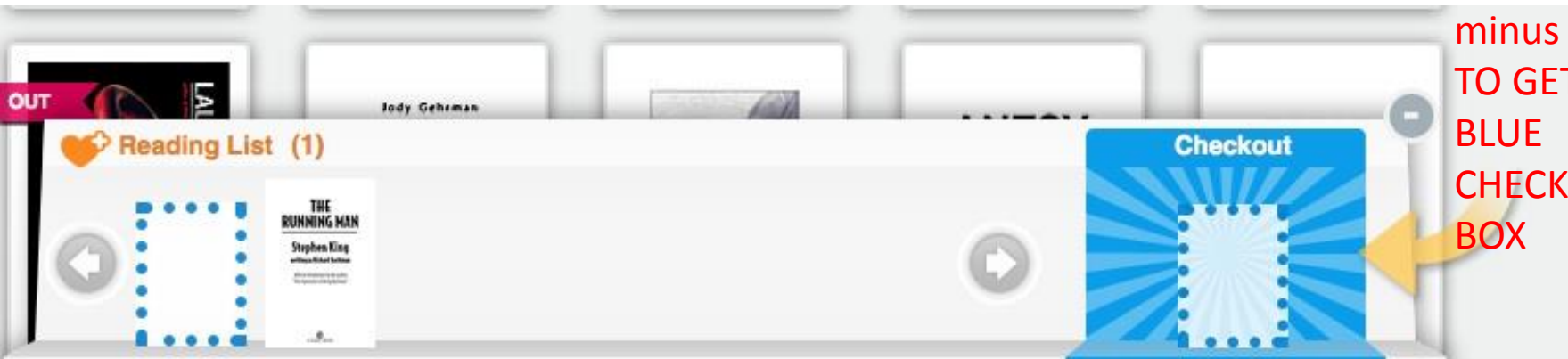
