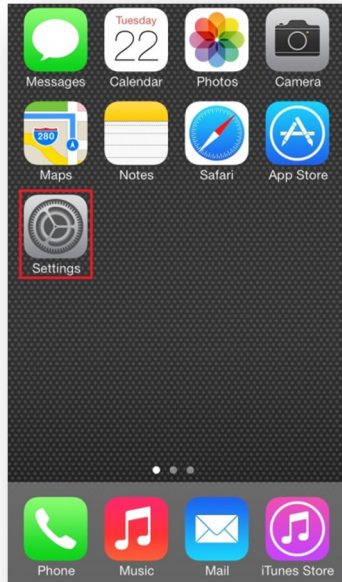


How Do I Synchronize My iPhone with My Register.com Email?

Perform the following steps to synchronize your iPhone with your Register.com email:

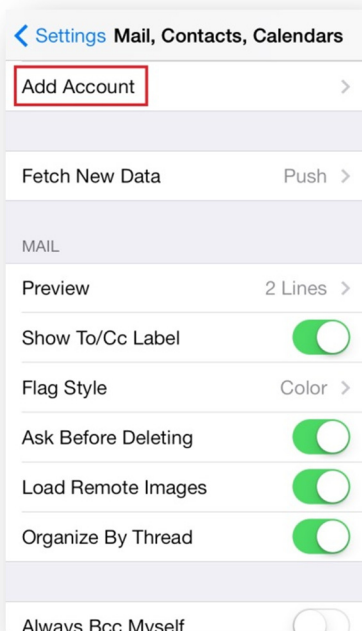
1. Press the **Home** button on the bottom of your iPhone and select **Settings**.



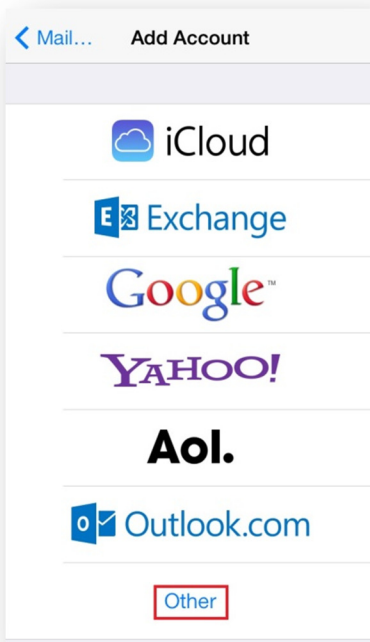
2. Select the **Mail, Contacts, Calendars** button.



3. Select Add Account.



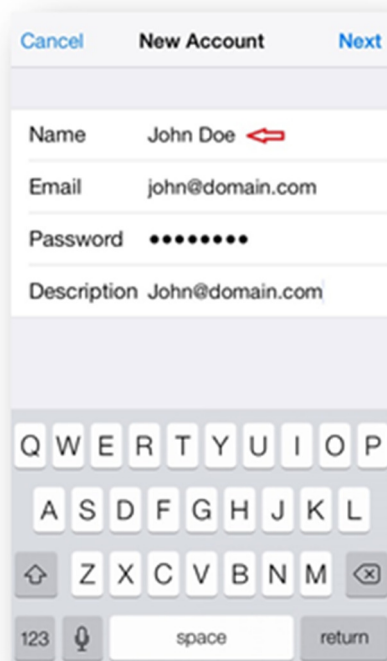
4. Select **Other**.




5. Select **Add Mail Account**.



6. In the **Name** section, enter the name that you want recipients to see when they receive email from you.




7. In the **Email** section, enter your email address.


Note: The **Outgoing Mail Server** settings are the same as the **Incoming Mail Server** settings.
