

## Unifrog – A guide to how to log in for the first time or if you have forgot your password

Step 1 – Go to your school Gmail account and look for an email from Unifrog, open it up and the following message should appear:

### Ahia! You haven't logged in for a while!

Hey [student\_firstname]! [student\_last\_login] Every week over 150,000 students in more than 150 countries log in to Unifrog.

Step 4 – Type in your school email ([firstname.secondname@ellisguilford.co.uk](mailto:firstname.secondname@ellisguilford.co.uk)) and create a new password and retype it underneath

Step 5 – Press to log in and a screen will appear for you to enter your school email and the new password you just created
