- 5. Click Continue.




Figure 2: lynda.com Login Page

- 2. Click Playlists




Figure 7: Lynda.com profile options

3. From the playlists page, click the create new playlist button. Or, select add to a new playlist... from the flyout menu on the + button to create a new playlist and add a course to it.






Figure 8: Lynda.com Creating a New Playlist




Figure 11: Lynda.com Share Link

6. Add the link to your course via eCourseware Content tool or add Quicklink




Figure 12: eCourseware Create a Link






Figure 13: Add Lynda.com Link to eCourseware

- 2. Click embed code icon




Figure 14: Click Embed Icon




Figure 16: Create a New File
