Online Access

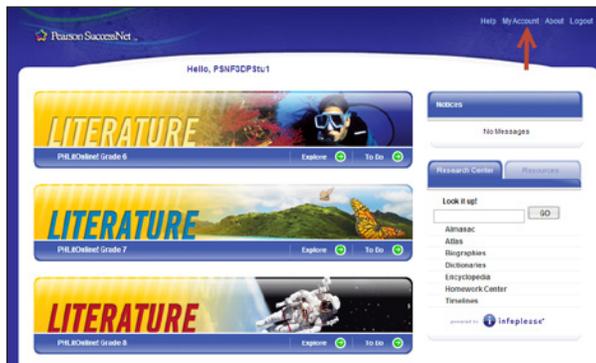
Student accounts are created by either a Pearson SuccessNet® administrator or teacher. After receiving your username and password, go to <http://www.pearsonsuccessnet.com> and log in.

Class Enrollment

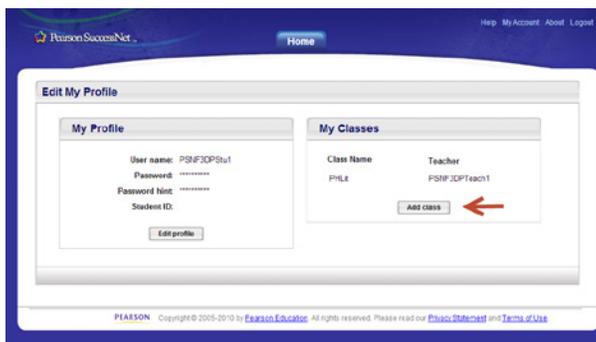
Your teacher may provide you with a class access code that allows you to enroll in a specific class.

Follow these steps to enroll in the class:

1. Click **My Account**.



2. Click **Add class**.



3. Enter the class access code provided by your teacher, and click **Next**.

4. Click **Finish** to complete the process.

You now have access to your class and can explore the digital curriculum and student book that is associated with the class.

Change Your Password

If the My Account link appears on your Home page, you have the ability to change your password. The minimum password length is six characters. Passwords must also contain one letter and one number or special character. Passwords cannot match or contain your username, first name, or last name in its entirety.

Follow these steps to change your password:

1. Click **My Account**, and then click **Edit profile**.

2. Enter your new password in the Password and Confirm password fields.
3. Enter a hint for your new password, and click **Save Profile** to save the new password.
