



1 Create an account

Go to the Education Community.

Go to the [Education Community products page](#) and click “Get Started” on the Fusion 360® product tile.




Sign in to your account or create an Autodesk account.



When you create a new account, identify your role.

Enter the country in which your school is located, identify whether you’re a student or an educator, and confirm your institution type.

Note: It is important to correctly select your institution type, since this informs the school list from which you’ll need to confirm the name of your school later in the process.

Additional documentation needed

Please upload a copy of documentation issued to you by your educational institution (e.g. tuition receipt or student ID, employee ID) as proof that you attend, teach or are employed at a Qualified Educational Institution.

You have 14 days to upload your documentation

The document must include:

1. Your full legal name (Rejected text)
Note: The name on the document you submit must match this.
2. The name of the educational institution at which you are enrolled or employed (Ocean View High (Huntington Beach, CA))
Note: The school name on the document you submit must match this.
3. A date within the current school term.

Preferred documents include:

- Transcript
- School-issued confirmation letter
- A copy of your student ID (photo ID not required)

Supported file types: JPEG, PDF, PNG, GIF

NOTE: If your uploaded document is too fuzzy to read, does not show your full and legal name, or shows a name different from the one you used for this Autodesk account, you will not be able to finalize the verification process. Please do not include any confidential information in the document you upload, such as social security numbers or banking details. Please ensure any sensitive information is blacked out before you upload your document.

Examples of preferred documents




You may be required to upload a document confirming your enrollment or employment status. It is essential that the documentation you provide fulfills the three criteria shown on the left.

Once your document has been submitted it may take up to 48 hours for your eligibility status to be determined by SheerID, our third-party verification services provider.

Note that you have up to 14 days to upload a suitable document, and you will not be able to access Autodesk products and services through the Education plan until your eligibility has been confirmed. You have a maximum of three attempts to provide acceptable documentation.


Examples of documentation that may be suitable include:

- Registration receipt
- Tuition receipt
- Student ID (A photo is not required and can be excluded. Dates must be included.)
- Official letter from the educational institution (See here for an example of the [student template](#), [faculty template](#) or [IT/lab administrator template](#))
- Transcript
- Employee ID or link to faculty listing on school website (A photo is not required and can be excluded.)




3 You will receive an email confirming your eligibility status

When your eligibility for educational access to Autodesk software and services is confirmed, you will receive a confirmation email.




4 Get product

Once your educational access has been approved, return to the [Education Community](#) and click "Get product" on the Fusion 360 tile.




Click "Access."

This will initiate the desktop client installation.



A new browser window opens and the Fusion 360 desktop client downloads automatically.


If the install does not automatically start, please click the link to try again.



Set up Fusion 360.

Once the download file is opened, Fusion 360 will go through a setup process, and you will be presented with an installation bar.

Note: When the install completes, Fusion 360 will launch automatically. This may take a few minutes.



Sign in to Fusion 360 using your Autodesk account with education profile credentials.

Note: Sign in to Fusion 360 using the same account details you used to confirm your eligibility for free educational access.

Hello Todd, welcome to Fusion 360!

In Fusion 360, everything happens inside a team. A team is a collaborative environment where you can store design data and work on your own or with collaborators.

Whether you are the only member of your team or collaborating, you are always in control of your data and can define who can access it.

If you are a new Fusion 360 user, the first time you log in to Fusion 360 you will be asked for a Team Name. Enter a name for your team site. This could be your name.

This is where your data will be stored and where projects will be created or moved to.

Click “Next.”

Hello Todd, welcome to Fusion 360!

Now it's time to create your team, "Team". Because you're using a public or educational email address (samwhewitt@gmail.com), your team will only be visible to people you invite to it. In other words, people will not be able to find your team in lists or join it without an invitation. This is done to protect your data.

If you would prefer to create a team that is discoverable and automatically joinable by colleagues, sign in to Fusion 360 using a corporate email address. This is helpful for organizations who want their employees to join existing teams instead of creating their own. You can still make this type of team private if you prefer.

Do not allow discovery

Do not allow other people from gmail.com to discover your team. You will need to invite each team member manually.

Allow discovery and automatic join

Make your team discoverable and allow people from gmail.com to join automatically.



“Click Create” as the option to not allow your Fusion Team to be discovered will automatically be selected.




