DECLARATION OF CITIZENSHIP MUST ACCOMPANY ALL APPLICATIONS FOR INITIAL LICENSING

The "SAVE Act" requires every state government entity, to verify that *every <u>adult</u>* applicant for a professional license is either a U.S. citizen, a "qualified alien," or a nonimmigrant who meets the requirements set out at 8 U.S.C. 1621.
