

Digital AP1s Faster, simpler, with fewer requisitions



Using HM Land Registry's Business Gateway for Digital Applications

What is the HM Land Registry Business Gateway?

It's a suite of services that enable customers to connect their systems to us so they can get information from the land register and send data and applications into HM Land Registry for processing.

These services are created using APIs.*

*What is an API?

API stands for Application Programming Interface. In simple terms it's a bit of software that allows two applications to talk to each other and exchange information. In our context this is often a case management system talking to the HM Land Registry database.

The Business Gateway Suite of Services

There are a range of services that customers can connect with to exchange data with HM Land Registry. Here are a few examples:

- the Application Enquiry service which will let you know if there are any pending applications that are lodged against a given title.
- Official Search of Whole Protects the register for the applicant for a period of 28 days and provides details of any relevant pending application or priority official search entered on the day list since the search from date.
- Register Extract Service provides an XML summary of key data from the Register plus the whole register in XML.

To create and submit digital AP1s you will need to use the e-Document Registration Service (e-DRS), and the following services help improve accuracy and add validation to the process:

- Registered Proprietor Name (RPN), which presents the name of the proprietor as held on the register and helps to avoid issues with names not matching on applications coming soon
- Register Extract Service
- Official Search of Whole




How to connect to the HMLR Business Gateway?

There are a two main ways you can connect to the Business Gateway:

- 1 **Indirect integration**, using a third party that is already connected or can connect you.
- 2 **Direct integration** between your software platform (e.g. case management system) and the e-DRS and RPN APIs.

The option you take depends a lot on your current set up and future objectives

Benefits: Creating a digital AP1 using the Business Gateway e-DRS service will:

Make your processes more efficient – you can submit directly to HM Land Registry from your case management system, instead of downloading an AP1 from your case management or forms provider then uploading it to the HMLR Portal.

Improve application quality by removing the need for re-keying information which reduces basic typos and errors; and being specific about what information to include.

It can help speed up the time it takes to process your application – when we receive an application via the e-DRS service we can automate parts of the processing done to review and complete the registration.

Using the Business Gateway platform gives you the flexibility to build a system that directly meets the needs of your organisation.

What to expect if you connect via a third party:

Your case management provider may already have a connection to Business Gateway – it's worth checking with them first.

If not, we can help you build the connectivity or you may choose to partner with another supplier.



Submitting digital applications

Submitting applications through Business Gateway removes the need to download the AP1 form and then upload it to Land Registry Portal.

You submit the data and we create the AP1 for you, removing the need to re-key information and therefore reducing the risk of errors. Validation of some of this data can happen throughout the conveyancing process to give confidence that this is accurate.

After submission, your system can collect updates and progress information on your application.
