

Steps to login Studies Weekly website

Step 1: Go to www.studiesweekly.com



Step 2: Type your username and password.

For majority of the students the username is the first name and the word bpa. If two kids have the same first name, write the first name, add the initial of the last name and the word bpa. Ex: johanabpa


The password is the same for ALL students: bpa2019

Username: (first name of student and bpa) EX: johanabpa


Password: bpa2019

Step 4: Click on Florida Studies Weekly 4th grade



Step 5: You will see on the screen the diverse publications of the newspaper going by week. Scroll down to look for the week assigned by the teacher.
