


Technology in the Classroom – Padlet

Wallwisher has changed its name to **Padlet**. No worries! All of the old walls you created in Wallwisher still work and can be accessed from the updated site. If you're new to Padlet, visit www.padlet.com to get started. **Need ideas?** To get ideas of different ways to use Padlet, click on the blue **Gallery** button.

Getting Started

- You do not need to setup an account to use Padlet, but it is a good idea to setup an account to easily access and edit all the walls you've created. Click on the green button, **Login or Signup**, to create an account. Click on the gray **Sign Up** button on the right side to enter an email address and create a password for your account. You can also log in with a Google account, if you have one.



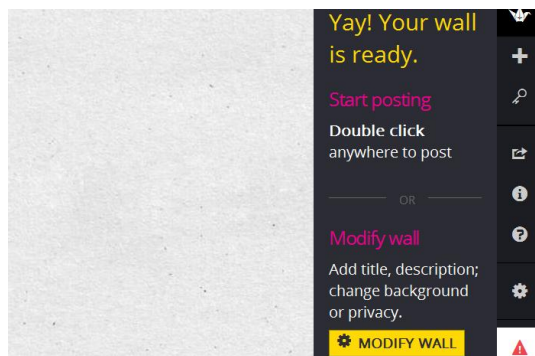

- Or click on **Build a wall** to immediately get started. And your wall will automatically be created, which you can modify before sharing it. If you decide to build a wall first, you will have the option to setup an account later (see the You section below).



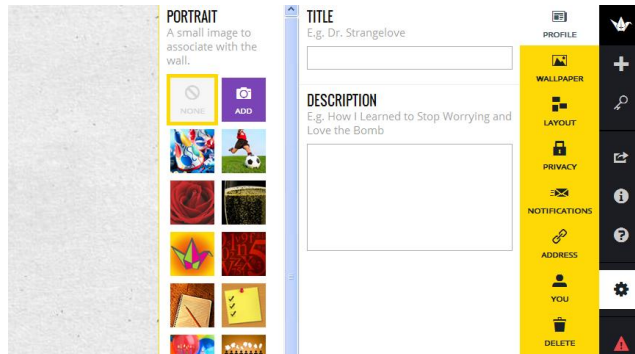
Building a Wall

- Click **Build a wall**, and click the yellow button, **Modify Wall** on the right to make changes to your wall.

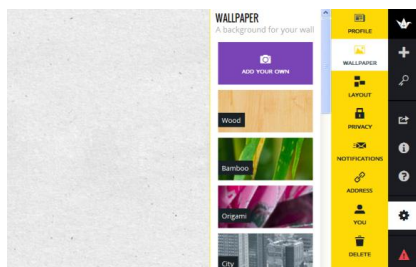


- **Profile**

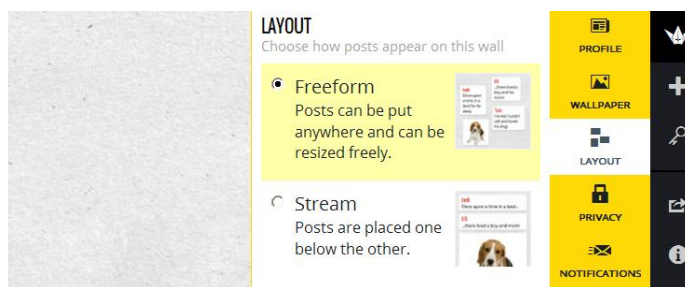
- **Portrait** – Add a thumbnail picture to your wall. Choose one of the provided images or upload your own.
- **Title** – Give your wall a title. (Ex. Word of the Day, Math Problem, Favorite Food, Animal vs. Plant Cell, etc)
- **Description** – You can explain what you want the students to write about on the wall here. (Ex. Give one difference and one similarity between an animal and plant cell)



- **Wallpaper** – Click here to change the background of your wall.



- **Layout** – Change how the posts appear on your wall.
 - **Freeform** – posts can be added anywhere on the wall
 - **Stream** – posts are placed one below the other in chronological order, with the newest post on top.



- **Privacy** – Choose who can read, write, and moderate posts. If you choose to approve (moderate) posts before others can see them, you will have to go to the wall to approve each post before they are visible on the wall.

VISIBILITY
How public you want this wall to be? Choose one

Only you and people you add by email can access this wall.

☐ Password Protected
Visitors will be required to enter this password to access this wall.

☐ Hidden Link
The wall will have a public link, but the link will be hidden from Google and public areas of Padlet.

☒ **Totally Public**
The wall will be public. It can show up in Google searches and can be featured by Padlet on the homepage.

MORE PRIVACY CONTROLS
More ways to control how people use this wall

☐ **Moderate posts**
Posts require approval by one of the moderators before they show up on the wall for the other readers.

- **Notifications** – You have the option to be notified when students post on the wall. Using this feature requires you to have a Padlet account.
- **Address** – Padlet creates a generic URL address for your created wall. Pick a **padlet.com** address to create a unique address for your wall that's easier to remember (e.g. padlet.com/wall/Smith-Adjectives). Addresses must be 6-20 characters and can only contain letters, numbers, - and _. Your students will visit this padlet.com address to post on your wall.
