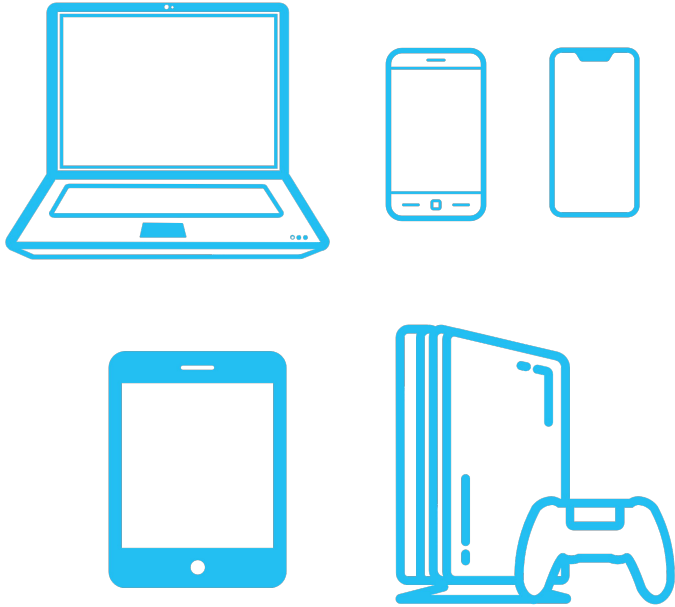
What is Google Classroom?



Teachers use Google Classroom to

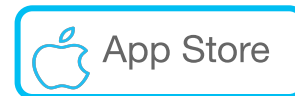
- » Share materials and resources

- » Gaming Device



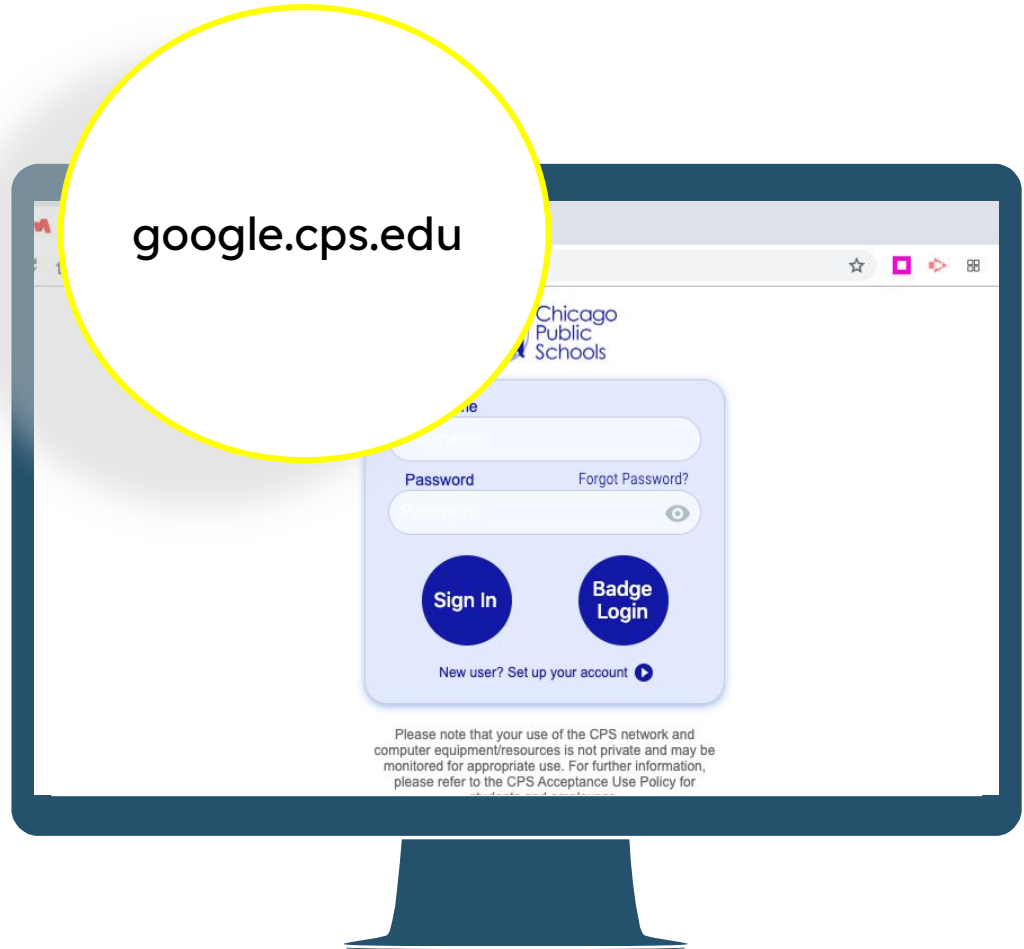
Accessing Google Classroom

To access Google Classroom, you will need your child's CPS username and password.

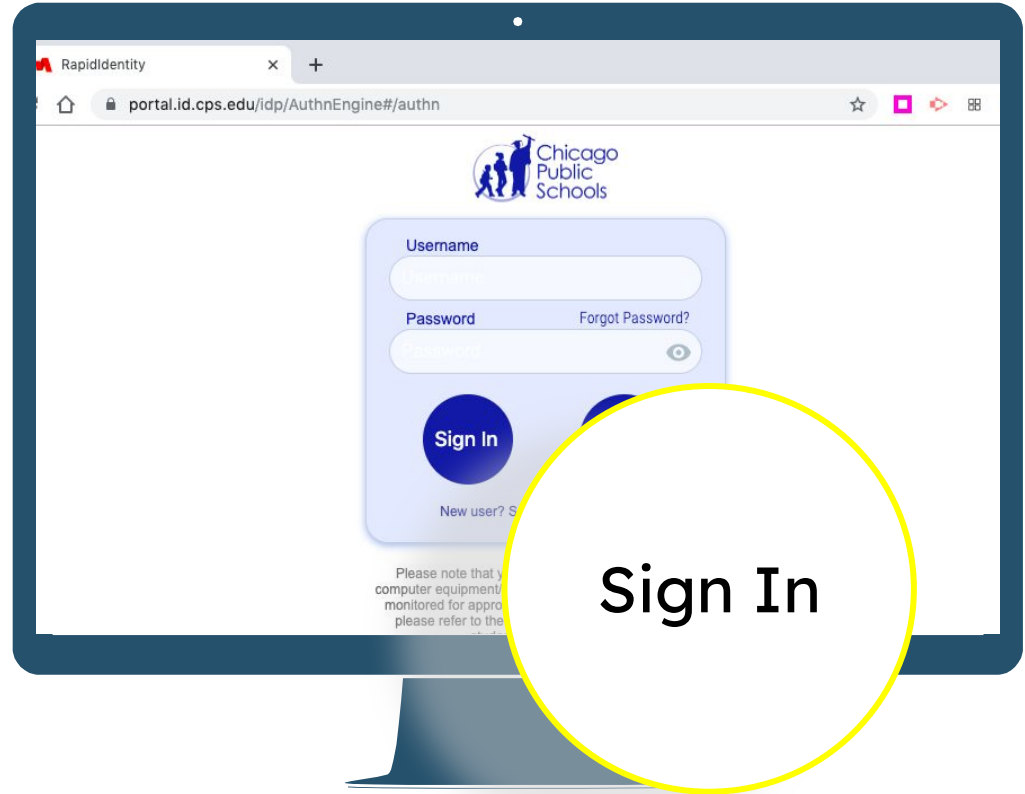
If you do not know the username and password, contact your child's teacher.

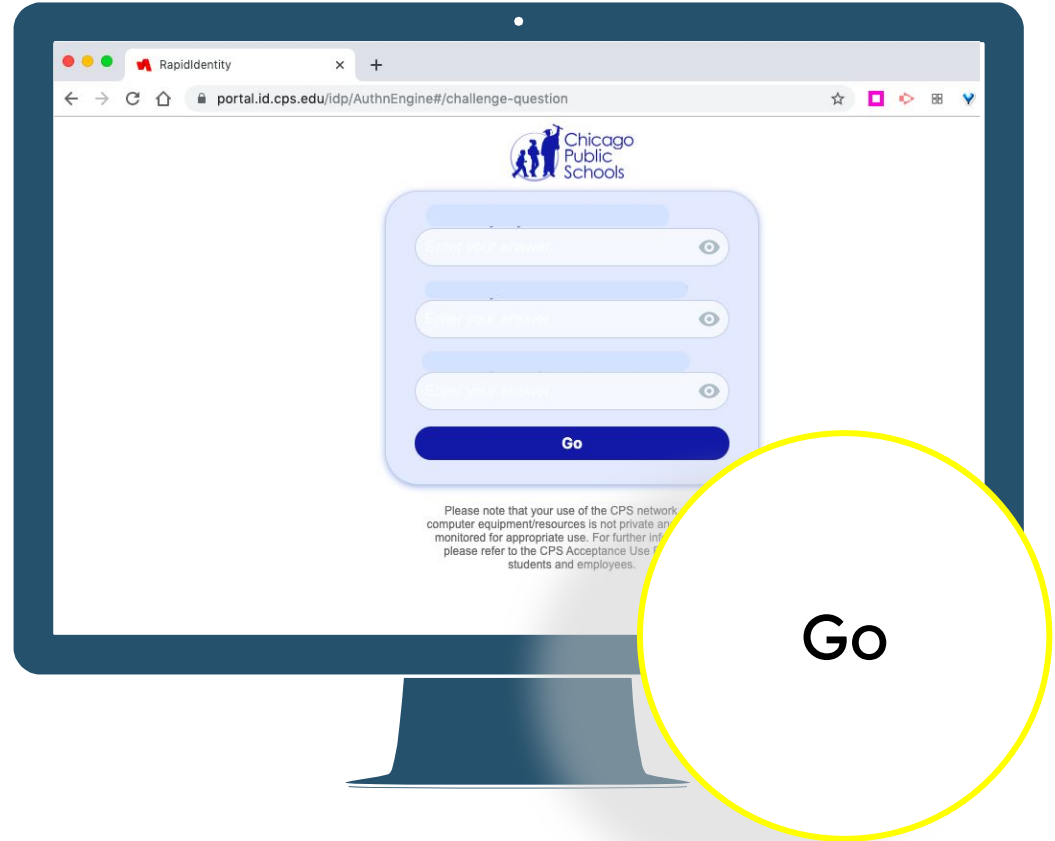

Click “Sign In”



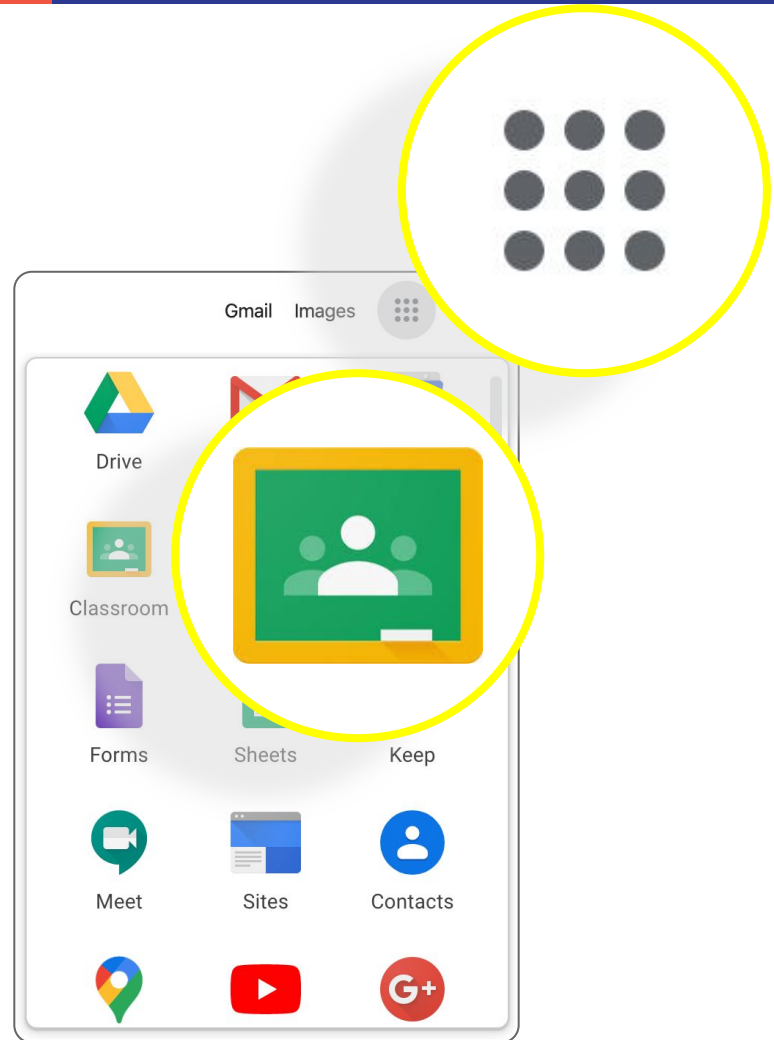
Young students DO

Just Click Go.

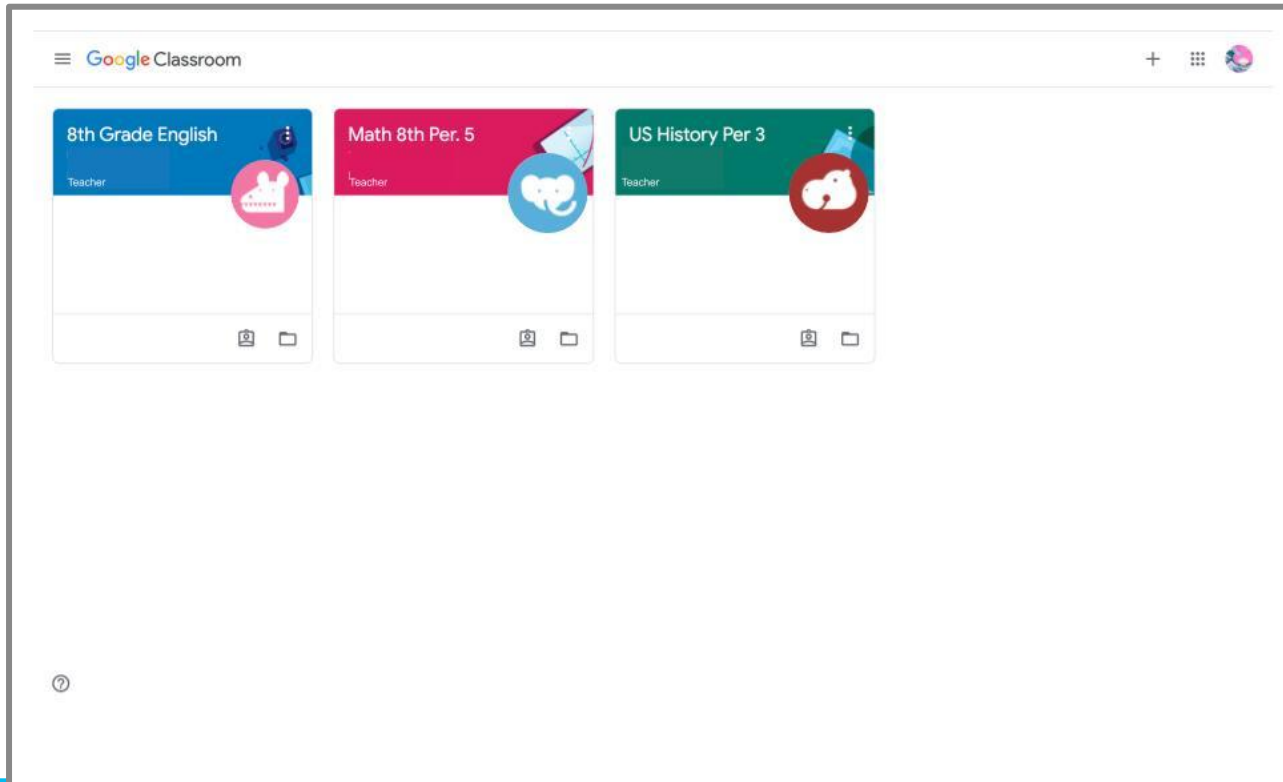


**Click on the “waffle”

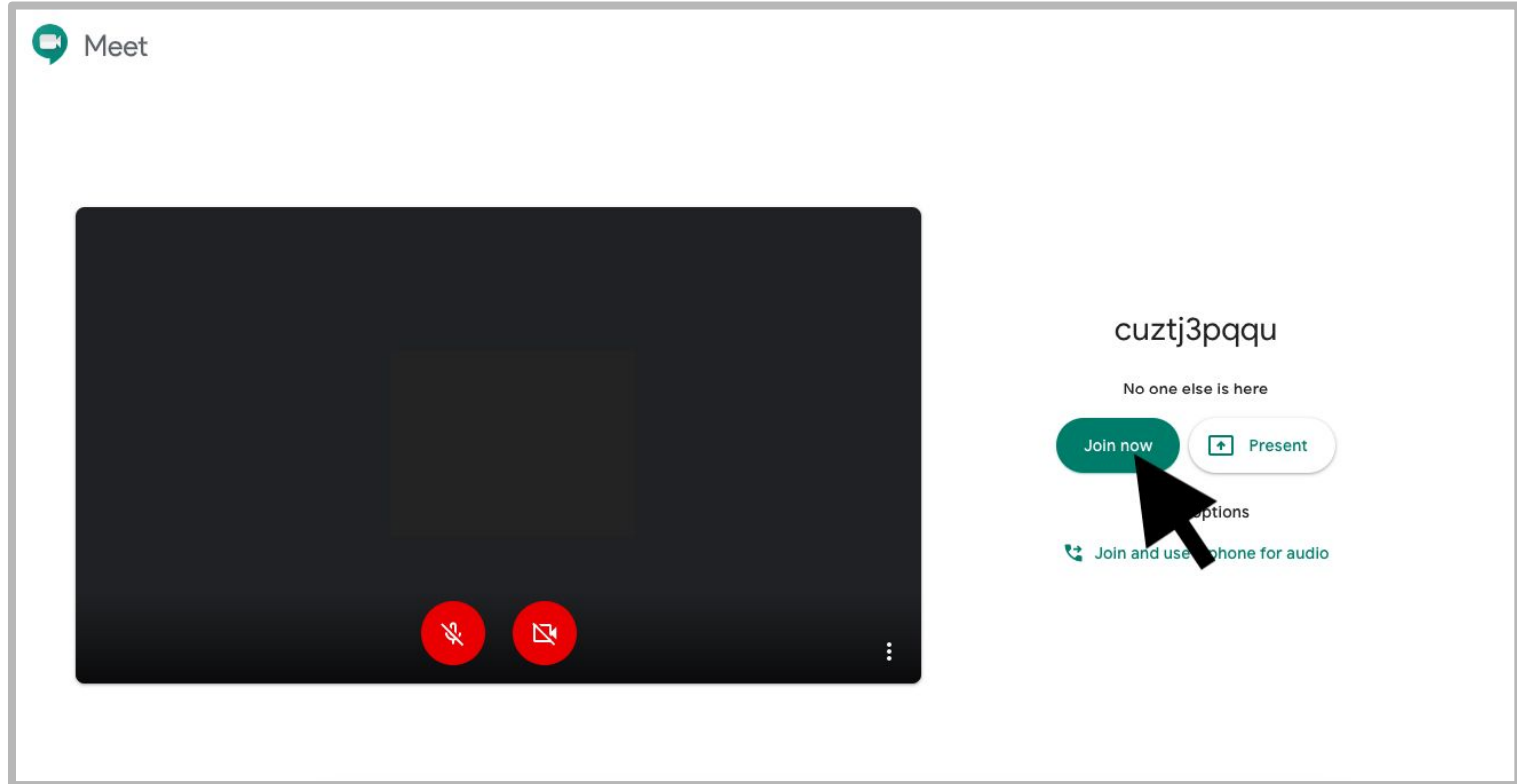

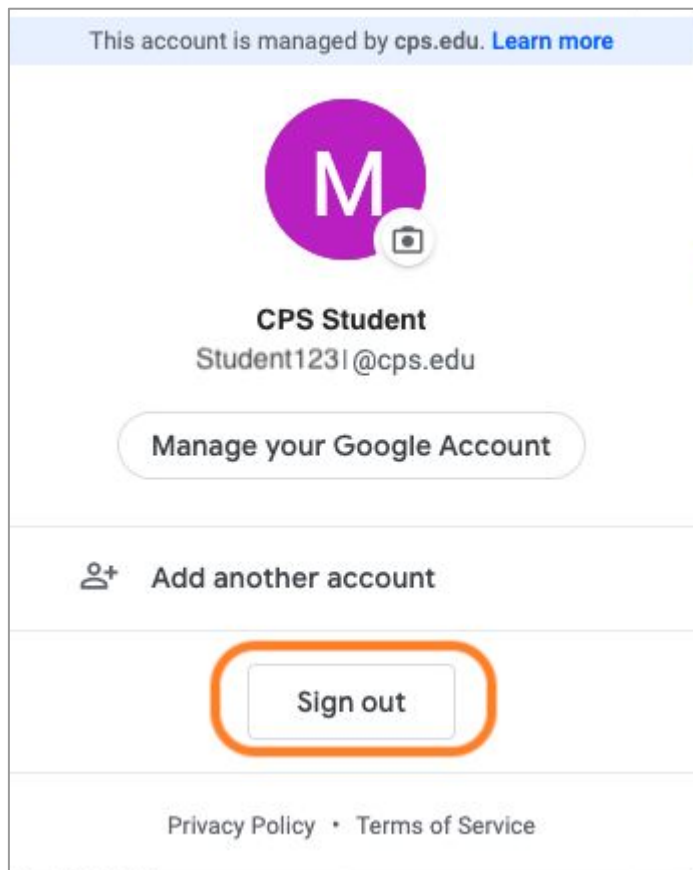


Click “Join Now” to join the class meeting
