Welcome to Pearson EasyBridge Plus!

Everett Public Schools uses a variety of Pearson Products for different content areas. In order for teachers and students to be automatically added and updated nightly and for students to access a wide variety of Pearson products through one point of access, teachers and students use a URL address that is unique to Everett Public Schools.

This link to **Pearson** is located in Chrome under Bookmarks>*Managed Bookmarks*, on the EPS Google Apps shortcut page and on Internet Explorer favorites. There is also a link on the Grades&More page to Pearson as well.

Logging in* to a district Windows computer onsite within our network -automatically logs you in to <u>Pearson</u>. Chromebooks still require using a user name and password.

Log in for both staff and students is the same user name and password used to log onto a district computer.

*Specialists, administrators and other staff who do not have assigned classes in eSchool– you need to request access by emailing <u>LMSStaff@everettsd.org</u>.

Q: How to get to the log in page for both students and teachers?

A: Different routes to same place

- 1. In Internet Explorer the shortcut to Pearson has been updated to link to Pearson
- 2. In Chrome select Bookmarks>Managed Bookmarks>Pearson
- 3. Grades&More site has added a Curriculum and Instruction Tools page with a linked icon
- 4. EPS Google Apps Shortcuts Pearson

Q: How do I set up my classes to start each semester?

A: At the beginning of each semester you will Assign Product

- 1. Log in to Pearson EasyBridge- Pearson
- 2. Navigate to a class
- 3. Select Assign Product
- 4. Find the right product on Pearson Product list
- 5. Check all boxes that apply to the course and scroll to bottom make certain to hit SAVE
- 6. Navigate to SuccessNet Plus platform through link on right of screen.

 - o Just click the link and you are logged in
 - o Students and teachers are automatically signed in to Pearson no password required
- Chromebooks or personal devices students or teachers will need to still log in through Pearson
 - User name and password are the same as your network log in (the way you log into computer)
